Year 6 Residential May 2025

Dear parent or carer

As we approach the end of a very successful year we start to plan for the next. This year has been full of new experiences and adventures for your child, next year will be the same. We would like to offer your child the opportunity to take part in a 2 night residential trip to Dukeshouse Wood in Hexham. The visit would take place on Monday 19th May 2024, the week following the SAT assessments. Children would be given the opportunity to participate in a range of adventurous activities in their 18-acre adventure park including abseiling, zip wire, 3G swing and motor sports. There is also an activity barn for indoor climbing, problem solving initiatives and a laser zone. The cost of the visit will be £265, which can be paid across the year. This includes early arrival, lunch and an additional activity on the first day. Pupil premium families who are entitled to free school meals can request further support from the school to reduce this further.

To secure a place, we will require a deposit of £20 by Monday 15th of July, with further payments of:

£90 due by 30th of September £90 due by 1st of December Remaining balance of £65 due by 20th of March 2024

Payments can be made at any time and in any amount via the My Child at School app.

As with any trip, paying the deposit is a commitment to attend and pay the remaining payments before the due dates. Everything required is included in the cost, there is no need to buy any new clothing or equipment for this trip.

As with any tour operator, the trip must be paid in full at least 12 weeks prior to travel. Tour Operator Residential Trip Cancellation Charges:Before 31st September - Deposit is non refundable
Between 1st of October and 20th of February £70 is non refundable
60 - 90 days of departure - 60% of the total cost is payable
30 - 60 days of Departure - 80% of the total cost is payable
0 - 30 days of departure - 100% of the total cost is payable

These charges still apply if a student is withdrawn due to behaviour, exclusion or leaving JCSC
